WHAT and HOW TO RECYCLE

NEWSPAPER: Throw newspapers into bin - loose, not wrapped with string or twine. "Mixed Paper" can also be thrown into the newspaper bin – this includes magazines, phone books, non-corrugated cardboard (cereal boxes, etc.) junk mail, and shredded paper.

NO TRASH (OR PLASTIC) IN THIS BIN STYROFOAM IS TRASH!!

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD: BOXES MUST BE BROKEN DOWN TO LAY FLAT AND STACKED NEATLY IN THE BIN.

No egg cartons, paper bags, Styrofoam or other food or beverage boxes/holders/cartons, detergent boxes.

PLASTIC MILK BOTTLES, DETERGENT, JUICE & WATER JUGS: ONLY CLEAN, RINSED & CRUSHED containers with the

HDPE "2 HDPE" label (usually found on the bottom of container) should be placed together in the designated bin.

DISCARD ALL CAPS / RINGS from containers.



PLASTIC SODA BOTTLES: ONLY CLEANED, RINSED & CRUSHED containers with the "1 PETE LABEL" (usually found pete or the bottom of container) should be placed in the soda bottle bin. DISCARD ALL CAPS / RINGS from containers.

ALUMINUM SODA & BEER CANS: ONLY CLEANED, RINSED aluminum beverage cans, should be placed together in the designated bin.

No Dog or Cat Food cans in this bin

GLASS: ONLY CLEANED, RINSED glass bottles and jars only should be placed in the bins. DISCARD ALL CAPS / RINGS from containers.

STEEL FOOD CONTAINERS: <u>ONLY</u> CLEANED, RINSED & NO LIDS <u>steel cans</u>, placed in the designated bin. **Dog and Cat food cans accepted in this bin.**

WASTE MOTOR OIL & VEHICLE BATTERIES: See Recycling Center personnel for disposal location.
