

## **Vote By Mail is Available for The May 23, 2023 Town Election**

There are a few ways in which you can request a Vote by Mail ballot for the May 23, 2023 Town Election.

The deadline to request a Vote by Mail ballot is **Tuesday, May 16, 2023 by 5:00pm** (*5 business days prior to the election*).

Step 1: Visit website provided, within this option, to print application or type your information in the fillable PDF then print completed application

Step 2: **Sign your application**

Step 3: Submit completed, **signed** application to the Town Clerk's Office by:

*Note: You must select a "Party for Primary Ballot" even though the local election a non-partisan election*
