The first major field operation of the 2020 Census has begun.

Address Canvassing began August 4 and continues through mid-October. Below are some available resources to assist in explaining Address Canvassing to community members:

Additionally, the Census Bureau is proactively working with local law enforcement.

- Our Office of Security sent a memo and a poster about Address Canvassing to each and every law enforcement agency in the country. The poster contains sample pictures of the official government badge with photo ID and the bag and laptop with the 2020 Census logo that address canvassers will have with them.
- In addition, via a partnership with the International Association of Chiefs of Police, every police station in the country will show the Address Canvassing video this week at the start of police shifts, known as roll call, so that police officers know the operation is occurring and how to identify a census worker.
