



Emergency Rental Assistance Available in Groton



In response to the loss of income to Groton households due to the coronavirus (COVID-19), the Town of Groton has created the Emergency Rental Assistance Program utilizing Community Preservation Act funds.

Applicants are eligible for:

- Up to **four months** of assistance
- Maximum monthly payment: \$800 - 1BR; \$1,000 - 2BR; \$1200 - 3BR.

Eligible Households:

- Total Household income (**at the time of application**) cannot exceed the following limits:

Household size	1 person	2 person	3 person	4 person	5 person	6 person
80% Income Limit	\$54,950	\$62,800	\$70,650	\$78,500	\$84,800	\$91,100
