**Stickers - Must be on your vehicle by July 1<sup>st</sup> and be affixed to the lower left corner of the windshield.**

**Stickers will not be valid if placed on other windows.**

**Bags** are required for the disposal of household trash.

**Trash bag size up to 45 gallons.**

**Shaw’s Supermarket** during normal business hours.

Bags are also available at the Transfer Station and the Clerk’s Office at the Town Hall.

15-gallon kitchen trash bags - \$ 15.00 for a sleeve of 10 bags

32-gallon medium size trash bags - \$25.00 for a sleeve of 10 bags

45-gallon largest size trash bags - \$30.00 for a sleeve of 10 bags

**VALID STICKER AND TOWN APPROVED BAGS ARE REQUIRED FOR TRASH DISPOSAL.**

**ANY RESIDENTS WHO CONTRACTS WITH A PRIVATE HAULER MAY USE THE TRANSFER STATION FOR RECYCLING AT NO CHARGE.**

**WHAT and HOW TO RECYCLE**

**NEWSPAPER:** Throw newspapers into bin - loose, not wrapped with string or twine. “Mixed Paper” can also be thrown into the newspaper bin – this includes magazines, phone books, non-corrugated cardboard (cereal boxes, etc.) junk mail, and shredded paper.

**NO TRASH (OR PLASTIC) IN THIS BIN STYROFOAM IS TRASH!!**

**CORRUGATED CARDBOARD:** BOXES MUST BE BROKEN DOWN TO LAY FLAT AND STACKED NEATLY IN THE BIN.

No egg cartons, paper bags, Styrofoam or other food or beverage boxes/holders/cartons, detergent boxes.

**PLASTIC MILK BOTTLES, DETERGENT, JUICE & WATER JUGS:** ONLY CLEAN, RINSED & CRUSHED containers with the



**HDPE** "2 HDPE" label (usually found on the bottom of container) should be placed together in the designated bin.

**REMOVE ALL CAPS / RINGS from containers.**



**PLASTIC SODA BOTTLES:** ONLY CLEANED, RINSED & CRUSHED containers with the “1 PETE LABEL” (usually found **PETE** on the bottom of container) should be placed in the soda bottle bin. **REMOVE ALL CAPS / RINGS from containers.**

**ALUMINUM SODA & BEER CANS:** ONLY CLEANED, RINSED aluminum beverage cans, should be placed together in the designated bin. **No Dog or Cat Food cans in this bin**

**GLASS:** ONLY CLEANED, RINSED glass bottles and jars only should be placed in the bins. **REMOVE ALL CAPS / RINGS from containers.**

**STEEL FOOD CONTAINERS:** ONLY CLEANED, RINSED & NO LIDS steel cans, placed in the designated bin.

**Dog and Cat food cans accepted in this bin.**

**WASTE MOTOR OIL & VEHICLE BATTERIES:** See Recycling Center personnel for disposal location.
